

## **Status Report as on 31.01.2017**

- Name of the Plant: Teesta Canal Bank Solar PV Power Plant (10 MW)
- The Teesta Canal Bank Solar PV Power Plant of 10 MW capacity has been commissioned on 18.08.2016 and inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of West Bengal on 23.08.2016.
- The plant is located near Teesta Canal Fall Hydro-electric Power Station, Stage II of WBSEDCL at Haftiagach, Chopra Block of Uttar Dinajpur.
- Total cost for installation of the plant is Rs.66.37 Crore including 5 years O & M, which is funded by MNRE, Govt. of India (Rs.15 Cr.) and State Govt. (Rs. 51.37 Cr.) under RIDF Tranche XXI of NABARD.
- Fund Status:
